Exceptional (7-10 points) Clearly indicates the student's intent to pursue a post-secondary education and clearly addresses how the scholarship will assist education plan. Well written essay showing good use of writing skills. In depth description of their future plans and how they plan to accomplish them. Gives specific examples of overcoming adversity.

Letters of Recommendation- 10pts

Discuss experience with the student and student's potential. Gives specific examples of attributes they believe the student has.
